## Required PPE: If students show up without one of the below items they will not be able to participate in the competition.

- 1. Hearing and/or ear protection
- 2. Safety Glasses
- 3. Welding helmet with appropriate filter plate/lens and protective cover plate/lens. Auto darkening
- 4. shields are permissible.
- 5. Oxy-fuel cutting full face shield or flip down attachment on grinding shield.
- 6. Full face clear grinding shield.
- 7. Steel Toe/Composite Toe Leather Work boots
- 8. Welding Gloves
- 9. Welding jacket (The Skills USA Work Shirt is Acceptable)

Required Equipment: The Below Items are mandatory equipment that are essential to student's success in the upcoming competition.

- 1. Chipping hammer
- 2. Wooden handle wire brush
- 3. GMAW Pliers
- 4. Tape measure
- 5. Wire brush carbon steel and stainless-steel brush (Stainless steel brush is only applicable for students who will be welding on Stainless/Aluminum)
- 6. Center Punch
- 7. MIG pliers
- 8. C-clamps /vise grips
- 9. Tip cleaners (oxy-fuel)
- 10. Soap stone
- 11. Square/combination square
- 12. Striker (oxy-fuel)
- 13. Compass or other circle drawing device
- 14. 10" Adjustable wrench
- 15. Pencil for written test
- 16. 4 ½" Grinder with applicable grinding disks.
- 17. Tig rig with consumables (Students will be able to hook up their Tig rigs and test them out on March 14<sup>th</sup> during the walkthrough)
  - a. Consumables include: Tungsten, Collets, Gas lens / Collet Body, Ceramic cups, Tails/Backcaps.

Note: Students are welcome to bring additional equipment to use in the competition (Ex: Triangle magnets). The following items will be prohibited: Wire Wheels, Cutting Templates, Anti-Spatter devices. Additionally, Flow meters are provided by MTC for all welding applications requiring external shielding gas.
