### Screen Printing Technology Competition Updates

**Date of Contest:** March 15, 2024

**Times:** Arrive no later than 8:30 am. The competition begins at 9:30 am. Each event within the competition lasts 20 minutes with a 10-minute break in between for cleanup. The competition should be completed by midafternoon. Any adjustments to this will be posted online or provided at the competition orientation.

**Events:**

1. Written Test – 20 minutes (This is a local test, more pertinent to local industry standards that may be utilized in addition to the online tests).
  - a. There is a Professional Development Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) that is also required to be completed by all competitors. Information regarding this test will be posted online.
2. Job Interview / Oral Assessment / Resume
  - a. Contestants should bring a hard copy of their resume for this IN ADDITION to turning in the required resume online.
  - b. Failure to turn in the online resume will result in a RESUME PENALTY. Failure to bring a hard copy to the interview will result in a deduction in the Job Interview scoring.
3. On Press Screen Registration – Register a new third color to an "in process" registered job and submit a proof to the judge. Ink will need to be added and positioned properly as per a proof provided.
4. Shirt Printing – Print as many production quality images as possible in the 20 minute time slot allotted. The print job will already be in register for a three color job.
5. Screen Art Image Registration - Align 4 film positives in the correct position for exposure on 4 screens for a four color job.

**Familiarization Needs for Competitors**

Competitors will be using Adobe CC Apps on Apple Computers for the competition and should be familiar with the system and software.
