## Both Tests – Unique Format Instructions

These instructions are for competitions requiring both the Professional Development Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) and a competition Skill Test at the 2024 SkillsUSA South Carolina State Leadership & Skills Conference but have a unique testing format compared to the majority of competitions.

## Advisor and Competitor Instructions by Competition

### Nurse Assisting

- This test will be taken at the time of the competition at the host school or at a time within the online testing window. Instructions will be sent out by March 15<sup>th</sup> to the lead advisor. Any scorecards being turned in will have the test scores added. They must be completed by March 25<sup>th</sup> at Noon.

- These competitions will be provided access to take the PD Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) which will count towards their score for the competition. They will also have access to a nationally provided test that does NOT count towards their competition score. This can be used for practice.
- The competitors will then take a test onsite at the competition area. Commercial sUAS Drone will require an electronic device (laptop) for their on-site test. All others will have either a device or pencil/paper provided.
- Information regarding proctors and testing procedures will be sent to the known lead advisor for the chapter it pertains to.



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## **Medical Math**

#### **Related Technical Math**

- These competitions will have competitors take the PD Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) in advance utilizing a school-provided proctor who is not the student's teacher during the online testing period. Information regarding proctors and testing procedures will be sent to the known lead advisor for the chapter.
- A hard copy test for the competition will be given on-site at the designated times in the schedule.

## **Baking & Pastry Arts**

- This testing must be completed fully in advance of the competition on March 23<sup>rd</sup>.

## **Welding**

### **Welding Fabrication**

- These competitions will take both the PD Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) and the competition skill test at the off-site location on the date of the competition. A proctor will be made available for the testing and testing will occur during a scheduled time. All competitors must provide their own electronic device (laptop, Chromebook, tablet, phone, etc.), fully charged and with Wi-Fi connection capabilities.

## **Graphic Imaging Sublimation**

### **Screen Printing Technology**

- These competitions will have both the PD Test (SkillsUSA Knowledge Test) and a nationally provided competition skill test made available online during the designated online testing period. The competitors may take these at their leisure within that period. Neither test will count towards their scoring. These are optional and can be used for practice for nationals.
- Competitors will take an on-site written test that will count towards their score.
