Conference Pre-Work

Each attendee must complete a series of pre-work items to be properly prepared for the Fall Leadership Conference. This applies to students and advisors, even those who have attended the conference and/or earned their statesman pin during a previous year. This pre-work is not something that is turned in digitally but is instead completed on an honors system. It is also recommended, for some parts, that a typed and printed version be brought with them (marked below). All these items should be completed prior to the start of the conference. These items may be completed individually or as a group. Depending on your device and connection, you may have to use a cellular device to watch videos. - Complete all Pre-Work prior to the conference.
- Complete the only SkillsUSA South Carolina FLC Knowledge Test (link on the website) earning a minimal required score. You should use the study guide provided (on the website) to study and watch all videos in Pre-Work to help with preparation.
- Participate in all conference sessions.
- Create and present an elevator speech on-site.
- Create and present a Framework Story on-site. It is suggested that you view the
